- By-law 19-5077 To Appoint a Committee of Adjustment (for a one year term, effective January 1, 2020)
- By-law 19-5078 To Amend Zoning By-law 04-4160 (50 Thames St. S.). The purpose of this by-law is
 to rezone lands municipally known as 50 Thames St. S. from 'Special Commercial Zone' to an amended
 Special Central Commercial Zone. The zone change is to amend the zoning to add an indoor selfstorage facility as an additional permitted use and also delete a tire manufacturing business as a
 temporary permitted use.
