How to Pay Your Property Taxes during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Town understands that many of our residents and businesses are facing financial challenges caused by the pandemic. If you need to delay your property tax installment, the Town will not charge penalty and interest until August 1, 2020. For those who are able, please pay your property tax installments when they are due using the following payment options:

- 1. **Telephone or online banking** using your home computer, tablet or cell phone. Please use your nineteen digit roll number that begins with 3218.
- Pre-authorized payment plan. Payments are automatically withdrawn from your bank account either monthly or on each of the four tax due dates. Please visit our website at <u>https://www.ingersoll.ca/property-taxes/</u> to complete the PAP enrolment form or send us an email to <u>finance@ingersoll.ca</u>.
- 3. **Mortgage Company.** You can make arrangements to have taxes included in your mortgage payments, please contact your mortgage company or bank.
- 4. In person at your local financial institution.
- 5. **Drop off your cheque in Town Hall secure drop box** located to the left of the front entrance. Please include the remittance slip with your cheque.
- 6. **Mail your cheque** or money order payment and remittance stub to the Town of Ingersoll, 130 Oxford Street, 2nd Floor, Ingersoll, ON, N5C 2V5. Post dated cheques are accepted.
